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Northern Rivers Family of Services has served the children, adults, and families of New York state since 1829 with a continuum of home-, clinic-, school-, and community-based, vocational rehabilitative, supported employment, and senior-supporting programs that provide person-centered, trauma-informed solutions to ensure clients live their best lives.

Today Northern Rivers serves more than 900 people each year throughout Rensselaer County.

### Behavioral Health Services

- Mobile Crisis Services teams are deployed to assist adults, children, adolescents, and their families resolve emotional and behavioral health crisis situations
- OnTrackNY, an intensive support program for young adults dealing with early-onset psychosis
- Home-Based Crisis Intervention provides intensive in-home services for families with children, help them to manage crises, build family relationships, and build life and coping skills

### Community-Based Services

- Prevention and family preservation, intensive programs designed to provide in-home support to keep children safely at home with families
- Health Home Care Management, for children, service coordination and support for those enrolled in a NYS Medicaid Health Home
- Home- and Community-Based (HCBS) and Child and Family Treatment and Support Services (CFTSS) provide home and community-based rehabilitative, therapeutic, and peer-driven supports

**Foster Care** provides comprehensive support for foster children, foster parents, and biological family to work toward reunification and permanency goals.

**Residential** and **Education** programs in Albany and Schenectady provide services to clients in Rensselaer County.
