Dear Early Head Start Families:

As you know, COVID-19 continues to impact nearly every aspect of our lives. Unfortunately, cases are trending upward nationwide and that trend has impacted us as well. Early Learning Center staff and families have reported exposure, testing, and quarantines over the past few weeks. We have also seen more young children, testing positive for the virus. While our staff wear masks throughout the day, and follow health and safety protocols, children younger than age 2 are not required to wear masks while in care. We want to continue to work in partnership with you to preserve everyone's health and safety.

Out of an abundance of caution, we have decided to <u>further extend our remote services for an additional week, and re-open Early Head Start for in-person instruction on Monday, February 1, 2021.</u> Early Head staff will continue to reach out to you to provide virtual services for your child, and supports for you and your family. We will also continue to deliver meals, diapers, and other supports during this time.

As it has been from day one of this crisis, safety is our foremost concern, and we continue to do everything in our power to protect our clients, staff, and community.
