

EARLY HEAD START

A federally funded program that provides free home- and community-based services to families struggling with poverty who are pregnant or have children from birth to age 3.

Highly trained staff help parents address children's needs in areas including health, early childhood development, literacy, and school readiness.

NEIL HELLMAN PRESCHOOL

A multiservice early childhood program for children between ages 3 and 5, including preschool special education, speech and language therapy, social work services, preventative childcare, psychological services, subsidized day care, self-pay day care, and universal prekindergarten.
