Substance Use and Family Dynamics information:-

Due to the ever-changing nature of substance use it is important that professionals working in child welfare have an awareness of commonly used mood altering substances as well as newer drug trends throughout New York State. This includes but is not limited to signs and symptoms of intoxication and withdrawal as well as associated paraphernalia. In addition to this it is imperative that child welfare workers understand the short term and longer term effects of Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) use on the wellbeing of the child and the family as a whole. Not only will this lead to better assessment of familial strengths needs and environments but it will assist the worker in engaging families in the planning process more effectively intervening with and referring children and families affected by Substance Use Disorders (SUD). The goal of the Substance Use and Family Dynamics training is to raise participants' awareness of commonly used substances signs and symptoms associated with use and drug trends in New York State as well as how parental drug use can affect child safety and risk. Participants will be able to educate children and families on the short term and longer term effects of AOD use. Moreover this training will provide best practice techniques for engaging and planning with youth and families around suspected or confirmed AOD use. Participants will also learn the potential effects of treatment and relapse on child safety permanency and wellbeing.
